**REDLANDS MEDICAL DIRECTOR ENGAGED IN OBAMA'S
PANEL DISCUSSION FOR HEALTHCARE REFORM**

**Redlands Community Hospital's Alexander Terrazas, MD, Joined 30 Other
Physicians to Washington DC Summit**

REDLANDS, CA-- As the nation moves forward to remake the our country's health care system, Redlands Community Hospital's Dr. Alexander Terrazas was invited by the Office of Budget and Management to participate in the administration's healthcare reform panel discussion held in Washington D.C. on May 27th, 2009. Approximately 30 physicians represented varying interests of academic, corporate and institutional medicine in the dialogue.

"We need to design a system that does not ration health care but delivers it in a more rational matter," said Terrazas, a family practice physician at Redlands Community Hospital. "The administration appears to be seeking input from all sides of the professional health care arena before selecting the architecture to develop their health care reform initiatives."

Dr. Terrazas, one of a handful of physicians at the meeting who practices medicine on a daily basis, provided input on how the proposed reform could affect primary care physicians in their daily delivery of health care services/

Dr. Terrazas is the Medical Director of Prime Care Medical Group of Redlands, part of North American Medical Management, local pioneers in the implementation of the electronic medical record in the Redlands area.

He has been a driving force in the evolution of physician practice management and has participated in levels of management from hospital and health plan utilization and quality management, to health care delivery design.

Dr. Terrazas has been in practice for more than 28 years in Redlands. He attended medical school at the University of Southern California, and completed his residency at San Bernardino County Medical Center.
